## DISCLOSURE - SCHOOL YEAR 2021-2022

Learning another language opens up endless opportunities and cultures. I love to teach Spanish and if you are willing, we will have fun this year and you'll speak, read and write Spanish at an unexpected level.

### CLASSROOM RULES:

1. **Be in class, be on time!!** This is not a regular class where you can miss and make it up with a few assignments. If you miss class or assignments, because of tardiness or absences, you will fall behind.
2. **Everyone must participate and speak Spanish**, no matter how goofy it may seem!
3. **Cell Phones may only be used when the teacher gives directions to use them for class.**
4. Everyone must be **positive** and show **respect** for all classmates & the teacher.
5. **Follow school policy** and consequences outlined in the student handbook. Including, but not limited to, dress code, language, attendance, make-up work, and cheating.

### EXPECTATIONS:

1. Speak Spanish. The best way to develop your Spanish is to stay in Spanish. If your buddies try to speak to you in English during class, tell them, "Esta es la clase de español!"
2. Bring your Chromebook charged and ready to use every day.
3. Participate fully in class, ask questions when necessary, and have fun!
4. Homework will be completed on time. Find it online on Canvas at [www.Tooeleschools.instructure.com](http://www.Tooeleschools.instructure.com) and [www.Duolingo.com](http://www.Duolingo.com), & other sites, handouts, projects, etc.
5. Canvas and Profe. Lopez's website [www.LopezClasses.com](http://www.LopezClasses.com) are the best resources for homework links, vocabulary lists, make-up, learning, etc.
6. Throughout the year, I will send reminders for classroom tests and assignments through texting and/or email. I have attached a page explaining how to register for [www.Remind.com](http://www.Remind.com). It's voluntary, but if you don't sign up for it, you won't get reminders, like your classmates. Parents can sign up for the reminders also.
7. Students will use computers in class and may do learning on the internet and they will be required to follow school policy when using computers.

### GRADING:

**Assignments:** 40% (Classroom Assignments, Reading Logs, etc)

**Homework:** 10% (Most homework is on Canvas and Duolingo)

**Assessments:** 50% (some quizzes will be unannounced; you will be given advanced notice for midterm and final exams.)  
*Students can retake assessments, but are limited to two retakes, in order to demonstrate proficiency.*

**Makeup Policy:** Late work will be accepted and assessed based on mastery/proficiency within three (3) weeks of the due date. Work turned in three calendar days (not class periods) before the end of quarter forfeits the opportunity for revisions due to quarter end deadlines. Late work will result in a 10% reduction in the overall score for that assignment.
